

Guidelines for Poster Presentations

- 1. The recommended poster size is 4 feet by 3 feet (LxB)
- 2. The poster board number assigned to the poster must be placed in the upper left-hand corner of the display.
- 3. Be sure to include the abstract title, author(indicate presenting author using an * mark) and coauthor names, and the institution(s) where research is underway, including your Author ID and e-mail address.
- 4. The poster should include following details viz , Introduction/Background, Methods, Results -discussion, Conclusions, key references and acknowledgement.

(Note: Posters should stimulate discussion, not give a long presentation. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure every item included in your poster is necessary and ideas flow logically from one section to the next. Kindly ensure that the Title of the poster should be legible from 20 feet away while Body text should legible from 6 feet away).

- 5. Double sided tape, pushpins, or thumbtacks will be provided to mount your poster.
- 6. Refer to your acceptance letter and/or the final conference program for the time and location of your poster session and set-up time.
- 7. The designated poster presenter (author or co-author) must be present at the assigned space during the designated time to discuss the work presented.
- 8. Delegates could refer to sample poster format for reference purpose
